The **Junior Motocross World Championship** will be held at **Circuit de Gueugnon Ste Radegonde, France**, on **August 21st, 22nd**.

The **Canadian Motorcycle Association** will assist one lucky rider in each of the 65cc and 125cc classes, with partial payment of expenses.

Note: The family / sponsor of the selected rider is responsible for the expenses of the support crew.

Additional riders may be selected to participate at their own expense.

The 65cc class is for riders aged minimum 10 and maximum 12

The 125cc class is for riders aged minimum 15 and maximum 18

Machines – 65cc Class – over 50 up to 65 cc 2 strokes /
– 125cc Class – over 100 up to 125 cc 2 strokes /

Notes: A rider has been seeded to the 85cc class
We are looking into the availability of rental motorcycles

If you would like to be considered, here's what you have to do:

1. Ask your parents to send us a letter indicating they would like you to be chosen to go to Dardon Gueugnon.
2. Tell us what brand of motorcycle you race.

The riders will be selected on the basis of performance, maturity and sportsmanship.
